WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the Associated Students, Inc. (ASI) at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) has a duty to highlight the contributions of those who have demonstrated a commitment to the enhancement of the educational and social experience of the campus community at CSULB; and

WHEREAS the 2018-19 ASI Senate urges the incoming 2019-20 Senate to address issues and concerns that have arisen in the 2018-19 academic year; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the incoming Senate continues to further develop all of the efforts the 2018-19 Senate has made on the following items:


- Increase ASI visibility and outreach to students at-large
- Increase CalFresh outreach and visibility
- Focus on concerns specific to graduate, transfer, and student athletes
- Continue to support the advocacy for housing and food insecure students through the Basic Needs program
- Explore the option of creating a shelter/housing facility for housing insecure students on campus
- Advocate for increased housing resources for housing insecure students where they do not need to exhaust loans to qualify for assistance
- Vocally oppose any potential tuition and fee increases if any occur
- Increase legislation to expand resources as opposed to focusing solely on event planning
- Continue "Meet the Senators" posters
- Encourage and facilitate informal meetings and get together for the incoming board members
- Encourage ASI leaders and senators to attend ASI events and ally trainings
- Revisit procedure for senators elected by college councils
- Hold ourselves and each other accountable to the community standards established
- Increase reports from director of the IPCDC and continuing the athletics highlights and game schedule
- Increase engagement on university-wide boards
- Actively and collaboratively strive to create highly functioning college councils
- Acquire information regarding sustainability and environmental justice from the Beach 2030 plan
- Explore sustainable alternatives to paper towels in the University Student Union
- Advocate for increased hydration stations across the campus
- Author legislation to institute consistent financial literacy workshops in both fall and spring semesters
- Providing safe spaces and support for students especially with the upcoming elections and current political climate
- Increase mental health resources through nontraditional avenues, including but not limited to peer mentoring
- Work on establishing CSULB as a polling location for the upcoming elections


- Advocate for ADA accommodations and size inclusive furniture in both ASI and campus-wide facilities
