WHEREAS the Associated Students, Incorporated (ASI) Board of Directors at California State University,

Long Beach (CSULB) is the recognized voice for over 37,000 students; and

WHEREAS the Human Resources Management Committee (HRMC) is the board responsible for personnel

and policy changes; and

WHEREAS the HRMC has been functioning as a redundant board to the Board of Control (BOC), and

WHEREAS there is a need to dissolve the HRMC due to the overlapping responsibilities the board holds

with BOC; and

WHEREAS that the AS Bylaws Chapter II Article V, Section 5, outlines the Duties and Powers of BOC as:

The Board will:

A. Employ, direct, and dismiss employees in positions established by the Senate.

B. Maintain and supervise the use of buildings and equipment under the control of the Associated Students.

C. Assist the Treasurer in preparing the annual budget for approval of the Senate; and

WHEREAS that in an effort to minimize any redundancy, CSULB ASI will move to dissolve the HRMC and

have the duties and responsibilities of that board return back to the BOC; and

WHEREAS dissolving the HRMC returns human resource functions to the BOC and accurately recognizes

BOC's role in personnel and finance matters; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that that Chapter II Article V, Section 5, be amended to amend point A and add point D:

The Board will:

A. Employ, direct, and dismiss employees in positions established by the Senate. Upon an anticipated or actual vacancy in the executive director position, the BOC shall have the authority to appoint an Executive Director Search Committee, inclusive of all voting BOC members as well as additional representatives voted on by the BOC.

B. Maintain and supervise the use of buildings and equipment under the control of the Associated Students.

C. Assist the Treasurer in preparing the annual budget for approval of the Senate.

D. Annually evaluate the Executive Director consistent with ASI personnel policies; and be it further

RESOLVED that in the event that an ASI Executive Director search is conducted, the BOC will facilitate that

process with the ASI President as Chair; and be it further,

RESOLVED that the membership of the ASI Executive Director search committee include all voting members

of the BOC, the Vice President of the Division of Student Affairs, one ASI professional staff

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representative, and any other additional representative can be voted on by the BOC; the membership is listed below:

- 1. ASI President, Chair of the committee
- 2. ASI Vice President
- 3. ASI Treasurer
- 4. Two (2) BOC Senate Representatives
- 5. One Faculty Representative selected by the Academic Senate
- 6. University President or designee
- 7. Vice President of the Division of Student Affairs
- 8. ASI Professional Staff Representative
- 9. ASI Student Staff Representative; and be it further

RESOLVED

that this resolution allows the Vice President the authority to reflect current changes of this resolution throughout the AS Bylaws; and be it finally
