WHEREAS the Associated Students, Incorporated (ASI) Board of Directors at California State University,

Long Beach (CSULB) is the recognized voice for over 37,000 students; and

WHEREAS the AS Bylaws Chapter II Article VI, Section 1 lists the officers of the Associated Students; and

WHEREAS the Chapter II Article VI, Sections 2, 3, and 4 outline the eligibility for all ASI Officers;² and

WHEREAS that Chapter II Article VI, Sections 2 states:

Section 2 Academic Eligibility of Officers

To be deemed academically eligible for any position in the Associated Students, the student officer must hold a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 and meet the university requirements for holding office stated in the current edition of CSULB Campus Regulations. The ASI Assistant Director for Government Affairs and Initiatives will be responsible for forwarding names of individuals who are currently holding or seeking to hold any position in the Associated Students to the Office of the Dean of Students for eligibility inquiry; and

WHEREAS that throughout the bylaws it is stated that ASI staff are not able to concurrently hold office while

they are a staff member; and

WHEREAS that ASI CSULB strives to represent "student self-determination in shared government of the

university... that advocate student needs and interests, compel student representation in

campus decision making;"3now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that in an effort to eliminate any conflict of interest within ASI CSULB, that Chapter II Article VI,

Section 2 be amended to reflect the following addition:

Section 4 Student Eligibility for Holding Office

To be deemed academically eligible for any position in the Associated Students, the student officer must hold a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 and meet the university requirements for holding office stated in the current edition of CSULB Campus Regulations. The ASI Assistant Director for Government Affairs and Initiatives will be responsible for forwarding names of individuals who are currently holding or seeking to hold any position in the Associated Students to the Office of the Dean of Students for eligibility inquiry
